**TOP THINGS TO DO & SEE**

**Buenos Aires:** The city of Buenos Aires has something for every visitor: beautiful parks, football stadiums, restaurants of all kinds, horse racing, riding, rose gardens, golf courses, night clubs, theatres, tango and opera. Shopping is an exciting experience along Florida street, around San Martin Plaza or in San Telmo where antiques are a specialty. The Italian Boca district, Palermo Parks, Recoleta Cemetery, San Telmo, the fashionable northern residential homes, the waterway of the Parana River, are all attractions that give Buenos Aires a character of its own.

**Iguazu Falls:** Iguazu means 'Big Water' in the local Guarani Language and is located on the Arentinean/Brazilian/Paraguayan border. The Falls themselves comprise a wide gorge with a series of gigantic waterfalls 2 miles long and more than 240 high. The thunderous roar of crashing water and the multicolored mist, which rises above the falls, makes for an unforgettable experience. Beautiful flowers, ferns, tropical plants, butterflies and exotic birds add to the exciting experience of close contact with nature.

**Mendoza:** Mendoza has a magic appeal and magnetism; it is full of history and traditions, and is the gateway to Chile over the great Andean range. The wine grown here is cherished across the country and exported throughout the world!

**San Carlos de Bariloche:** San Carlos de Bariloche is a small charming town on the Nahuel Huapi shores. From here you can go Skiing, fishing, walking, climbing, boating, visit lovely gardens and graceful homes and meet interesting people. Take a tour along the shores of lovely lakes or visting Victoria Island will be highlights of your trip to Argentina.

**El Calafate:** El Calafate is a little village in Patagonia, Argentina. It is situated in the southern border of Lake Argentino, in the southwest part of the Santa Cruz Province, about 320 km Northwest from Río Gallegos. El Calafate is an important tourist destination as the hub to visit different parts of the Los Glaciares National Park, including the Perito Moreno Glacier (one of the most visited in the world) and the Cerro Chaltén and Cerro Torre.
